Schedule

- Morning circle with lesson of the day
- Outdoor recess with water sprinkler play
- Activity period including project or craft, which is worked on throughout the week
- Snack time
- Second circle with music/movement, yoga or dancing
- Noon dismissal for some; lunch for others
- Nap: (Approximately one hour of sleep or quiet rest)
- After-nap activity, reading time, movement time
- Weekly trips to Van Vorst Park playground and water sprinkler

Session 1: Land (6/24 - 7/12) Dinosaurs

Dinosaurs continue to be a favorite topic of children of all ages. In this session campers will explore a variety of dinosaurs and their habitats. Rocks, minerals and fossils will also be studied and there will be a variety of related projects. These may include making a dinosaur model, panning for gems and minerals, building a volcano, casting a dinosaur egg, and a dinosaur dig!



Session 2: Water (7/15 - 8/2) Sharks

Sharks are fascinating creatures that have captured the imagination of people for centuries. This camp topic will help children learn more about these amazing animals through engaging and informative activities. Some key areas we will focus on will be: shark anatomy, shark species, shark habitats and shark behaviors.



Session 3: Air (8/5 - 8/16) Birds

This camp is designed to take your camper on a journey where they will explore the world of birds through science, art, sensory play, stories, and movement. Campers will explore the life-cycle of birds, their anatomical structure, learn about nests, create a pinecone bird feeder, engage in matching activities, and practice their Practical Life skills. We will use our handmade binoculars to investigate the world of birds on nature walks.
